Sermon Title: "Living Through Our Discouragement"

Big Idea: When we're feeling trapped and hopeless, God will

listen and provide what we need

Scripture: Numbers 11:10-17 and 1 Kings 19:1-6

Message Highlights:

- Moses was not the only prophet who felt crushed under the weight of leadership in trying times.
- Elijah and Jeremiah are two examples of others who despaired.
- Notice the extent of their despair → wishing they were either dead or hadn't been born! (Elijah: 1 Kings 19:4; Jeremiah 20:14,17,18; Moses: Numbers 11:15)
- Notice how Moses lamented to God → through questions (not grumbling nor complaining)
- What can we take away from these three meltdowns?
 - Releasing/venting our anguish to God can be productive
 - Ask God to remind us show us how "He is able" to handle anything
 - Anticipate how God will help us through the "valley of the shadow of death"
- Notice how God responded to each of the prophets (Moses: Numbers 11:16-17; Jeremiah 20:11,13; Elijah: 1 Kings 19:5-18)
- How should we not respond? (relying only on our own human resources)
- How *should* we respond? (Trusting God, talking and listening to God, anticipating His provision)
- Remember Psalm 23
