Sermon Outline

Sermon Title: "How do we respond to the Messiah?"

Big Idea: While human nature makes us want to preserve or promote ourselves and our traditions, our Faith makes us want to love and honour Jesus.

Scripture: Matthew 2: 1-12

Message Outline:

- 1. Traditional story and carols about the Three Kings from the East do not line up with the biblical account
- 2. The account in Matthew 2 pits both the worldly powers (King Herod) and the religious ones (the chief priests and teachers of the Law) against Jesus, Messiah, Son of God
- 3. We must ask ourselves:
 - a. Has God called us to a journey of sacrifice we've been unwilling to undertake?
 - b. Has God called us to make commit our time, resources or possessions to His work?
 - c. What does "bowing down" to Jesus look like for each of us?
